<b>Foreign Quota:</b>	If a National Ski Association wishes to expand their NAC quota to the FIS level, a letter from the NSA must be submitted to ACA ( <a href="mailto:raceentries@alpinecanada.org">raceentries@alpinecanada.org</a> ), at least 10 days prior to the first TC' meeting in order to be considered. Approval will be subject to current entry levels and may not be determined until the first TC' meeting.	
<b>EQUIPMENT:</b>	As per ICR Art.222.1, all equipment must confirm to the FIS regulations. The competitor is responsible for the equipment she uses. Equipment will be subject to inspection in the start area.	
<b>ENTRY FEES:</b>	70.00 \$ per day including taxes and lift ticket in CAD currency. Payable between 4h00 PM et 6h00 PM, March 16 <sup>th</sup> at Race Office located above the Patrol's Clinic.
